



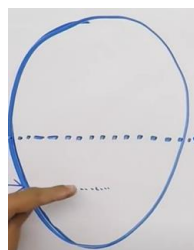

Self- Portraits

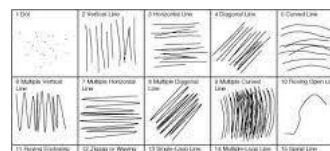
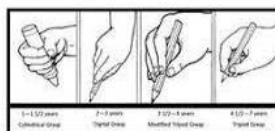
A self-portrait is the study of your face, looking closely at your eyes, nose, mouth and other features. Use a mirror to have a look at yourself practice drawing different parts. Build up your face gradually.



Techniques

Use a pencil to create different marks on a surface. Think about using careful grip and applying pressure to achieve lighter/darker marks. Explore drawing different body parts you can see.
