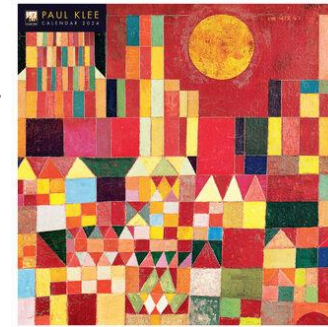
Artist exploration

Vocabulary	Definition
Water colour	Paint thinned with water giving a transparent colour.
Primary colours	There are 3 primary colours; red, yellow & blue.
Secondary colours	Three secondary colours; orange, purple, green.
Wet on dry	Layering water colours
Fluid	An abstract painting technique that involves the use of fluid art mediums.



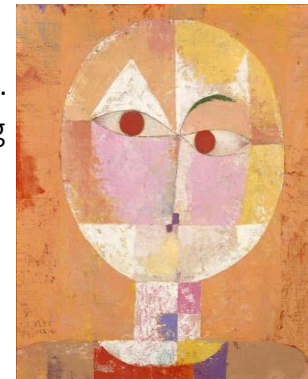
Emma Burleigh
