Batik

Vocabulary	Definition
Batik	A method of producing coloured designs on textiles by dyeing, having first applied wax.
Wax resist	A type of glaze decoration that involves the application of a coat of one glaze, painting a wax pattern, and then applying the second glaze.
Realism	To represent subject matter truthfully.
Impressionism	Capturing the movement of life through small, thin brush strokes.
Abstract	To separate/withdraw something from something else.



Artist exploration

Marica Williams

Marcia is inspired by the beauty of waves, butterflies, and birds. She uses watercolour for her paintings as she loves the luminescent translucent quality of the paint.



Anna Blatman

Anna is inspired by her garden, especially the flowers. She enjoys watching the light playing off them. This essence translates directly into the textural nature of her paintings ~ layering tone on tone.



Wax resist

Explore using a glaze (brush) as a background and then paint a wax pattern on top. Apply a second coat of the same or different glaze to reveal the pattern.

Experiment creating different tones by layering water colour paint on top of each other. Use lines, dots and patterns to explore creating different shapes.
