By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

0 + 1 = 1	0 + 4 = 4
1 + 0 = 1	1 + 3 = 4

1 + 1 = 2	4 + 0 = 4
2 + 0 = 2

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

<u>Use practical resources</u> — Your child has one potato on their plate and you give them three more. Can they predict how many they will have now? Thread six beads onto a pipe clean- how many ways can they find to split them into 2 groups?

<u>Make a poster</u> – Your child could make a poster showing the different ways of making 5.

<u>Play games</u> — Write 0-5 on lots of cards (3 of each should be plenty!). Turn them upside down. Take it in turns to pick a pair- if they make 5 you can keep them! The player with the most cards at the end wins.
