KS1- Hockey



Year 1

- To demonstrate how to move with a ball using a hockey stick.
- To learn how to stop a ball whilst trying to use one side of the stick.
- To display how to attempt a push pass to a partner using the hockey stick.
- To aim to pass the ball to a partner in an unopposed situation.
- To introduce basic shooting techniques using the smash shot.
- To gain an understanding of the fundamental rules in hockey.
- To understand the concept of teamwork in hockey.
- To combine at least one or two skills in a game situation.

Year 2

- To demonstrate how to move with a ball in different directions using a hockey stick.
- To learn how to stop a ball whilst using only one side of the stick.
- To display how to attempt a push pass to a partner and how to receive one under control.
- To be able to pass the ball to a partner in an unopposed situation and keep control of the ball.
- To develop shooting accuracy and power whilst aiming at different parts of the goal using the smash shot technique.
- To show an understanding of the fundamental rules in a game setting.
- To understand the concept of teamwork and different positions in hockey.
- To combine both defensive and attacking skills in a game situation.
